The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was led by Al Bourke.


This meeting was held to go over the budget and to vote to open it up for public inspection.

Budget. A line by line description was given for the budget. On motion made by Dave, seconded by Chuck it was voted to open the budget for public inspection. (2-0)

Kreger Farm. This farm is considered for an agricultural conservation easement by the State Department of Agriculture. It is in two Townships Polk & Chestnuthill, with the largest portion in Chestnuthill. Since the Department will only take the farm if it is in one Township it was decided to keep the farm in Chestnuthill. On motion made by Dave, seconded by Chuck it was voted to sign a letter to MCPC for this purpose. (2-0)
